Stewardship is the sharing of time, talent, and treasure to support the Church and God's greater community.

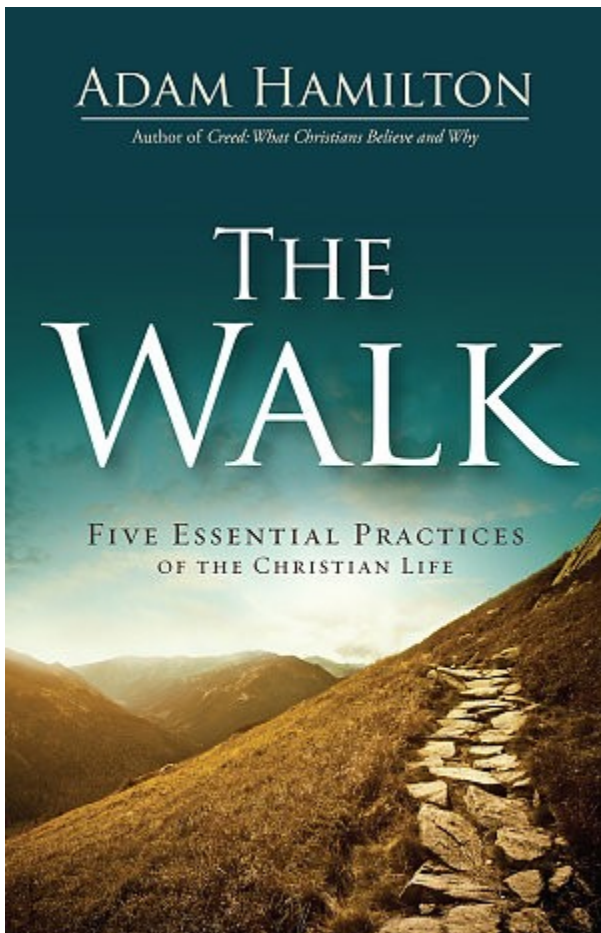
PRAYER REQUESTS – November 1st, 2020

Last Sunday was All Saints' Day, and it celebrates the people in the church who have passed here on earth and have entered into heaven. One of the hymns either the congregation or the choir would sing is "For All the Saints" (UMH 711).

Looking ahead to Christmas, the Missions Team is asking for your help with Sidewalk Sunday School, Save the Family and I-HELP.

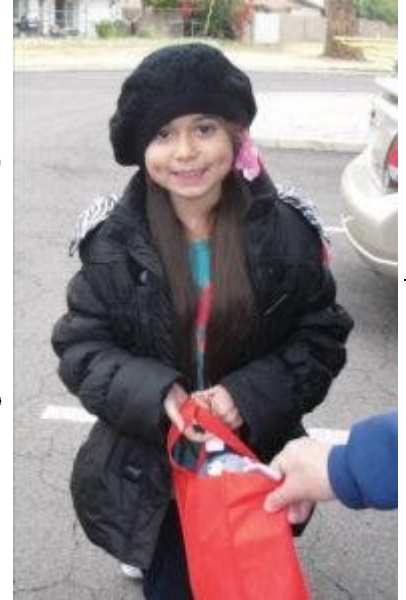

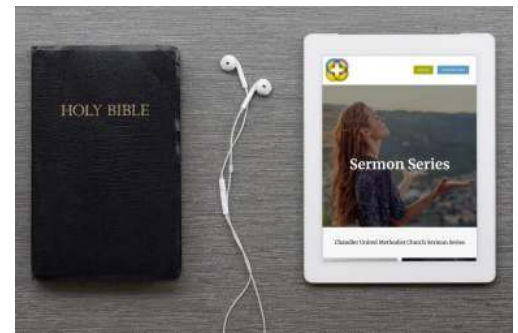
