#### CHURCH FINANCIAL UPDATE

First, I would like to take the opportunity to wish everyone a very Merry Christmas and the most blessed of New Years. May joy and happiness fill your Christmas stockings. November income was much improved over the previous seven months even excluding the donations to pay off the mortgage. This allowed us to increase our cash balance by approximately \$7,600. With added revenue, we can consider improving program offerings especially in our children's education offerings. We can also look to doing some maintenance items such as carpet cleaning that we have had to let go for a while. Pledges are still coming in, but as of today, we have 71 pledges for approximately \$370,000.
