Our Communion offering and offerings designated for Missions will go to Arizona Justice For Our Neighbors to provide low-income legal services to immigrants, refugees and asylum seekers in the Desert Southwest Conference.

AZ Justice is a branch of UMCOR, the United Methodist Committee on Relief. UMCOR was originally founded in 1940 as the Methodist Committee on Overseas Relief. Then Bishop Herbert Welch was responding to displaced and vulnerable people in the wake of World War II when he said the organization would serve as a "voice of conscience among Methodists to act in the relief of human suffering without distinction of race, color or creed."

In 1986, UMCOR began reaching out to local congregations regarding immigration issues and at the same time, providing funding for immigration projects within United Methodist Districts. One such project was Just Neighbors, founded in 1996 in Annandale, VA. The organization set out to provide accurate and reliable information and services, including legal services, to the immigrant community. Based on the Just Neighbors model and with its support, UMCOR established the national Justice for Our Neighbors just three years later. Currently, there are 19 Justice for Our Neighbor sites across the country.

AZ Justice serves low-income immigrants, refugees and asylum seekers on a sliding fee scale based on ability to pay. Clients come with various legal questions, but most are seeking assistance with citizenship questions. You can find more information at AZJFON.org or NJFON.org




### LIFE (Live In Faith Everyday) Group Bible Study

## Dear Elizabeth, Thanks to you, Robert is safe

Your generosity brings hope to those who need it most. You make all the difference to neighbors in need like Robert—he has an incredible story!

Last summer, Robert was living in his car and driving for Uber. He had been diagnosed with cancer for the third time, and the stress of his illness had led him and his wife to divorce.

Then all of a sudden, Robert was hit from behind. The crash totaled his car, and he was taken to the emergency room in an ambulance.

## Imagine losing everything

"My vehicle was everything," he said. Without it, Robert couldn't work and wound up living on the streets.

Then Robert heard about AZCEND. He walked straight here and received help right away. That night, Robert enjoyed a hot, nourishing meal and a safe place to sleep giving him the stability he needed to thrive.
