January & February - Leadership Study, different topics each week

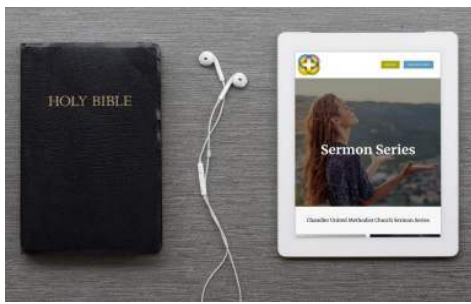
February 18th - Ash Wednesday - Movie: The Way
