My Sisters' Place, a 24-hour Domestic Violence Shelter is a program of Catholic Charities. The goal of our program is to provide safety and shelter to domestic violence survivors while educating them about health relationships and providing community resources. It is our hope that survivors leaving the shelter will be able to maintain a violence-free lifestyle. Our facility provides housing for up to 30 individuals: men, women and children, three meals a day and basic needs at no cost to our survivors. In addition to shelter, we operate a 24-hour crisis line, which for many survivors is their first step in reaching out for help. The shelter also provides case management services, individual and group counseling, children services and victim advocacy through our Pathways program. We would not be able to provide these services without the help of our community.

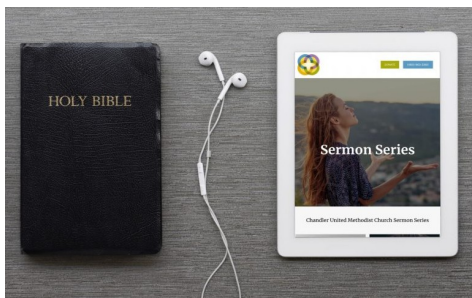
