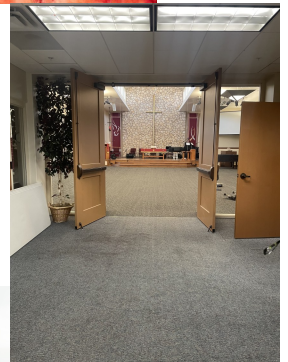

His conversion story is dramatic, and the reach of his ministry is enormous. He has been seen as a staunch defender of the status quo, an egotist, a proponent of “correct” doctrine, even a misogynist. Is this really who he was? We will take a deeper, and perhaps surprising, look at Paul through a presentation by Richard Rohr called “Paul as Liberator” in our Monday night zoom meeting in this 6 week study. 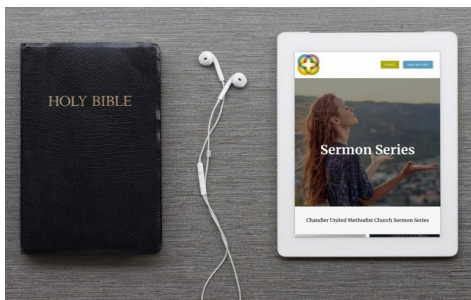
