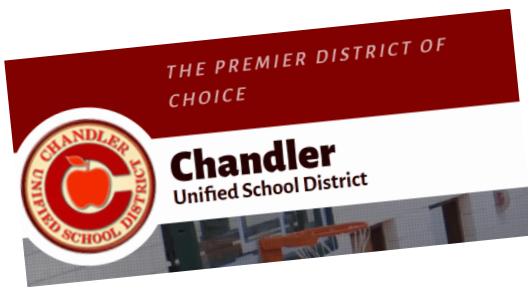

F.I.T. is a program created to assist children and youth who are experiencing homelessness to succeed in school.

The McKinney-Vento Act was established to guarantee homeless youth the same educational services provided to all

students.

CUSD's F.I.T. program can assist families and youth who are living in transitional housing with an array of services such as clothing, food, school fees, utility bills, medical/dental services, and much, much more.

F.I.T. will use our monetary donations to purchase Walmart gift cards. Students will use these to purchase clothes, groceries, school supplies, hygiene items, etc.

F.I.T. buys Walmart cards specifically because they restrict certain purchases (such as alcohol).

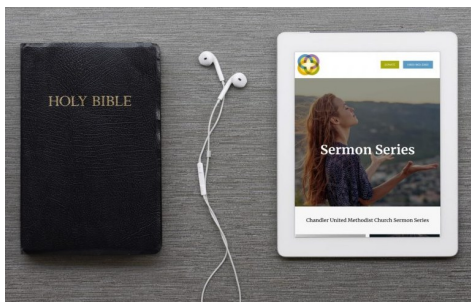
