His Hands and Feet Sewing Ministry is always looking for volunteers who want to join in and sew for charity.



During the **August Communion** offering there will be collection to benefit Helen's Hope Chest which does meaningful work to improve the lives of foster kids in the Phoenix area. Helen's Hope Chest is a nonprofit whose mission is to support foster kids by providing a one-stop shop for free clothing, shoes, birthday gifts, essential hygiene items, and books. Helen's Hope Chest supports on average 600 foster children each month.

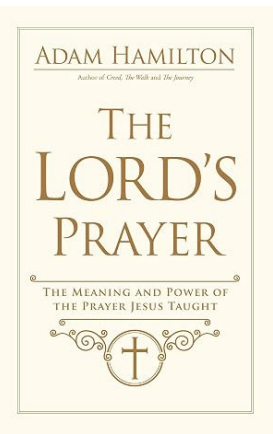
