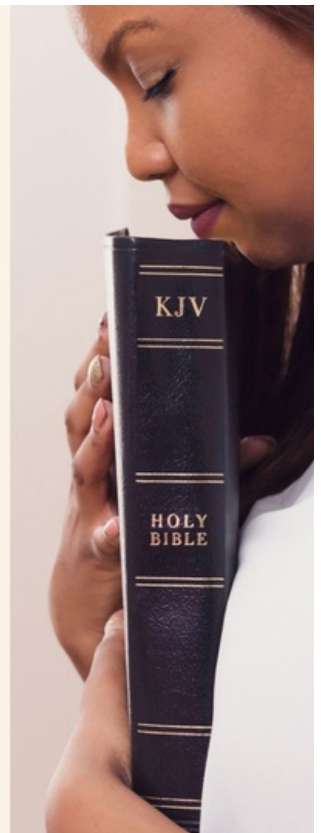
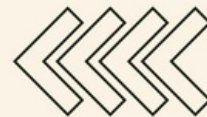
- Marcie Fuller requests prayer for Corey Franklin. He is waiting for a new heart at the Mayo clinic in Minnesota. He is 44 years old.

The bags will also be a useful item for them to have. During August, we will be collecting the bags, new washcloths, and travel hygiene items. We especially need sunscreen, lip balm, and lotion. MISSIONS – JUSTA CENTER

Our mission focus for September is Justa Center. This is a United Methodist ministry and day center for seniors who are experiencing homelessness. Aging can be a challenge for anyone, but people who have no home, no income and no health insurance have a bigger struggle. They need help meeting daily needs of food and shelter, and also with health issues experienced by many as they age.

Founded in 2006, Justa Center works with men and women ages 55 and older to meet their basic needs and procure housing and income when possible. Roughly 130 people walk through Justa Center's doors every day, nearly 50 percent are veterans, and 42 percent of them are women. Members are provided coffee, showers, phone, internet access, lockers, laundry services and a library. Justa Center also cares for the spiritual needs of its members with weekday and weekend services.
